Academics:-

NCC

- Taniya Sharma of IX class attended NCC camp held at Srinagar from 22nd April to 1st May 2018.
- Girls of IX class also attended NCC camp, which was held at Nagrota from 26th May to 6th June, 2018.
- Girls of IX class attended NCC (CATC) Combined Annual Training camp, which was held at Nagrota from 2nd Nov. to 11th Nov.2018.

KARATE:

- National Karate Championship was held at Delhi on 20th to 22nd April, 2018. In which Yanchan Lamo of class VIII won gold medal.
- Colour belt promotion test was held on 19.7.2018 at MA stadium which was organized by Taekwondo Association Parth Sharma student of class III participated and received Red Belt. He also won Silver Medal in 20th State Level Taekwondo Championship organized by J & K Taekwondo Association

chief guest. SNS Vidya Mandir school stood 2nd in that competition.

YOGA

- Students of our school participated in the International Yoga Day which was held at Women's Parade College Jammu on 21st, June 2018.
- Department of Youth Services and Sports organized an Inter District Yoga championship at Nagrota, Jammu on 28.08.2018. More than 17 schools from J&K participated in this competition.
